



Internships at Platform for Intercultural Europe

Platform for Intercultural Europe hosts two interns per year for 4 to 6 months each, one in autumn/winter (September to February), the other in spring/summer (March to August).

Students of European Studies or Politics, especially those with an interest in arts & culture, cultural diversity, intercultural dialogue, migration & integration are particularly suitable for the posts. Students of cultural management with a strong interest in diversity issues and the EU as a framework for policy and practice exchange are also eligible. Our interns are usually given a distinct (research-based) project to work on, but are also involved in the implementation of current activities.

Please send your application:

- For the autumn/winter period by the previous 15th July, and for the spring/summer period by the previous 15th January
- ONLY by e-mail to: myriam.gemers@intercultural-europe.org mentioning in the subject line: your name + `internship' + desired internship period
- With a letter of motivation (1 page max) and CV (2 pages max).

To qualify you:

- Must be a student on a relevant (ideally postgraduate) university course (for example in European Studies or Cultural Policy) at the time of the internship and an internship must be a recognized element of the course
- Must have good, especially written, communication skills in English and at least one other European language, as well as a great analytical aptitude
- Must have good organisational, word processing and general computer skills
- Must have had experience of an office environment
- Must have a demonstrable interest in the work of the Platform for Intercultural Europe.

Notes:

- We only respond to candidates we are interested in
- Internships at PIE do not constitute employment and are not remunerated
- PIE offers reimbursement of stage related costs such as for accommodation and transport against presentation of evidence where the intern is not in receipt of a grant
- The ability to source your own funding is an advantage.
